

NOTICE TO POLIYCHOLDERS
New York Circular Letter 2022-12 and Executive Order 20.1 – Monkeypox Virus

New York Circular Letter 2022-12 was issued pursuant to Executive Order 20.1, which declared a state disaster emergency to combat the spread of the monkeypox virus.

With respect to grandfathered individual health policies, the Circular letter informs insurers that the Executive Order requires those policies to provide coverage for:

- monkeypox immunization and its administration (for both adults and children) without any deductible, coinsurance, or other cost sharing requirement.
- lab tests and ambulatory patient services, including office visits and urgent care, related to the monkeypox virus without application of lifetime limits; and
- telehealth services received in connection with the diagnosis of monkeypox to the same extent as diagnostic services received in person.

This coverage applies to Prudential's CHIP Special, CHIP standard, CMY -76, CMY-82, CMY-82A and CMY-82B policies issued and in force in New York.
